WHAT ABOUT ACADEMICS?

Academics at the preschool level include language, literacy, math, science, social studies, and school readiness skills. Preschool academics are woven throughout our curriculum, and appear in all that we do here. Our curriculum is highly individualized, which ensures success for all children. We focus on the whole child. Activities in preschool support social, emotional, cognitive, and physical growth. We also give your child tools to help them learn from mistakes, develop curiosity and thinking skills, resolve conflicts, develop language, etc. Once children have mastered the tools, the facts of education naturally fall into place.



The GSRP is Michigan's state-funded preschool program for four-year-old children with factors which may place them at risk of educational failure. The program is administered by the Michigan Department of Education, Office of Great Start.



WHAT WILL MY CHILD DO AT SMALL WONDERS PRESCHOOL?

A typical day includes circle time, free play, art, snack and small group time. Literacy, math science and music are integrated into each of these activities. For example, math concepts are explored during snack time when we compare more and less, or fill our cups half full of juice. Our day is also filled with literacy activities, from journal writing to alphabet puzzles. We provide a print-rich environment where children are encouraged to explore different facets of literacy. Preschoolers have daily exposure to stories, finger plays and songs.
